A Message from the Ministry

At Broken Vessel Ministries, our mission is to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ while meeting the urgent physical needs of those in Honduras. Guided by the commandment to "Love thy neighbor as thyself," we strive to make a positive impact on the lives of those we serve.

Total Donations Received: \$11,976.32

- Designated Donations: \$4,477.37
- Undesignated Donations: \$7,498.95

All donations are receipted and tracked in accordance with our ministry's accountability standards.

Total Assistance Provided: \$10,807.34

Funds were used for emergency aid, food, utilities, medical, and educational support. These funds were used to provide direct aid to individuals and families facing crisis or hardship. Every case is prayerfully reviewed to ensure genuine need, and no aid is issued without accountability or follow-up. We believe in holistic help—supporting the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of those we serve.

Operational Expenses: \$1,839.38

Covered completely by a private anonymous sponsor.

This amount includes: printing, postage, and office supplies, online platform and communication tools, occasional travel/mileage for ministry needs, and basic administrative costs.

Note: This generous sponsorship means that 100% of all public donations went directly to assistance, not overhead. We praise God for this unique provision!

Tangible Blessings:

-Built a home for a family in need—including beds and cooking supplies.

-Distributed 52 bags of food to struggling families.

- Made 40 house visits, ministering personally to individuals and families.*
- Hosted Vacation Bible School for over 220 children across 3 different locations.*
- Ministered to 40 women through several dedicated "Ladies Ministry" events.*
- Purchased 2 fans for a local school to improve learning conditions.*
- Provided medical care, including medications and doctor visits.*
- Distributed 70 medical supply bags to families in desperate need.*
- Provided 80 bags of seeds (tomato and pepper) to support home gardens.*
- Distributed 163 Bibles.*
- Helped a woman and her children escape physical abuse by installing 2 doors, 5 windows, and a toilet for safety.*
- Funded lunch meals for 100 kids through Hogar de Benidicion (the House of Blessing), four times per week.*
- Supplied school materials to children.*
- Set up 9 food accounts for the sick and elderly, allowing them to get weekly food.*
- Provided Ensure for a malnourished, disabled individual.*
- Donated 20 pieces of tin for roofing to help an elderly woman with shelter.*
- Bought diapers for three adults and a newborn.*
- Provided much-needed clothing to many orphaned children.*
- Donated supplies and appropriated financial assistance to local church leaders and missionaries to be distributed to the needy through their discernment.*
